

AGS BEDFORDSHIRE GROUP AUTUMN SHOW

To make up for the cancellation of our last two spring shows, a 'mini-show' will be held as part of our 2021 AGM, on Monday 4th October.

Show Rules:

1. Entries should be with the show secretaries by Friday 1st October, although late entries will be accepted on the night (subject to space).
2. Staging of exhibits will be from 18:30-19:15. Judging will begin at 19:15, at which point exhibitors will be asked to wait at the other end of the hall.
3. All exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor and on the day of the show plants must have been in their possession for at least six months.
4. Class 11 is only open to members who have not previously exhibited in the competitive plant sections at the Bedfordshire Group's annual show. Members who have exhibited in the monthly competition but not the show can enter this class.

Unless covered by the above, the rules contained in the most recent AGS shows handbook apply.

Schedule:

Exhibitors may have up to two entries per class. Pot sizes are not to exceed 36cm.

1. Three pans rock plants, distinct
2. One pan rock plant in flower
3. One pan Cyclamen
4. One pan bulbous plant
5. One pan dwarf shrub
6. One pan rock plant grown from seed by the exhibitor, date of sowing to be stated
7. One pan rock plant for foliage effect
8. One pan Crassulaceae (Sempervivum, Sedum, etc.)
9. One pan cushion plant
10. One pan dwarf conifer
11. One pan entered by someone who has not previously exhibited at the spring show (see rule 4)
12. One photo of alpine(s), printed or shown on the Group's laptop*
13. One piece of artwork of alpine(s)

There will be an award for best plant in show.
